Reader	<b><i>A Heart of Scorn:</i></b> Read the text to your child; discuss any vocabulary words	Shared reading of the text; introduce words you think may be tricky; let your child read some of the sentences with you	Release more responsibility to your child to read more of the text herself	Word Hunt through text (see OR/Short o activity-all OR words from text are on pg. 1 of reader)	Child reads text with limited support

As you call out words, have your child point to the head word under which each belongs
Sight Words	Intro new words for your child (5 at the most); see the Reader & Word-Wac-Woe for sight words	<b>Secret Sentence</b> activity sheet	Pick 10 sight words and put them in ABC order	<b>Roll &amp; Write a Sentence</b>	<b>Word-Wac-Woe</b> (sight word cards for lesson included)
Writing	Draw what you think Pharaoh's face looked like when Moses & Aaron came to him at first. Write about it.	Read Ex. 7-11. Pick 1 plague and draw what you think it looked like. Write about your picture.	Draw and Write: How do you listen to God? Show one way by drawing, then write about your picture.	Draw & Write: How do you think the people felt when they saw Pharaoh's army coming?	Dictation Sentence: <i>He had scorn for the people.</i>
Bible Verse	Read from the Bible: "Listen to His voice and hold fast to Him." Deuteronomy 30:20	<b>Cut &amp; Paste Bible Verse:</b> Child cuts words apart and glues them back in order on a piece of paper.	Why was it important that the Israelites listened to God? (then do writing activity)	Make up motions to go with your Bible verse. If you know sign language, try that!	Can you say the Bible verse without looking?
