

# Word-Wac-Woe

On the next pages are sight words pulled from the *God Made It All* reader.

Pick 15-20 words from the stack (or you could pick your own from the story) to print, cut them apart and laminate for durability.

Laminate or slip the Word-Wac-Woe board into a plastic sleeve protector.

Use dry erase marker.

## **To play:** (for 2-4 players)

1. Lay out the word cards that you have chosen so all of them can be seen.
2. All players pick 9 words (it's okay if you pick some of the same words) to write in their Word-Wac-Woe boards.
3. When done, shuffle all of the chosen word cards and place them face-down in a pile.
4. Players take turns picking off the top card, turning it over and reading the word.
5. If a player has that word on her gameboard, she can cross it off.
6. The first player to get 3 in a row, shouts "Word Wac Woe." The player can only win if she can read the three words. *You can also play until the whole board is covered.*
