

Directions for Pocket Chart Kk Book

- Cut apart words on the dotted lines and use in a pocket chart. If you do not have a pocket chart, a table top or floor space will work, too.
- Use the text from the Letter Kk Book to help your child re-create it on the pocket chart.
- Read the text aloud and ask the child to add pictures to each line of text (use the black & white or colored Kk picture cards).
- Read the text out loud again, pointing to each word (you can use your finger or a special pointer).
- Ask the child to give it a try, too and praise him for his efforts.

Suggestion: Print onto cardstock and laminate for durability.
