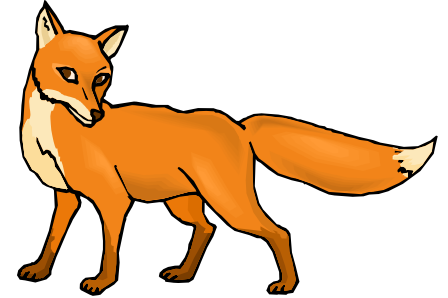


# How Many Foxes in the Box?

Print the mat (pg. 2) and number cards onto cardstock and laminate for durability.

## VERSION 1 (easier)

- \*Place some foxes on the box mat (pg. 2).
- \*Ask your child to count the number of foxes.
- \*Help him locate the number (from the number cards, pg. 4)



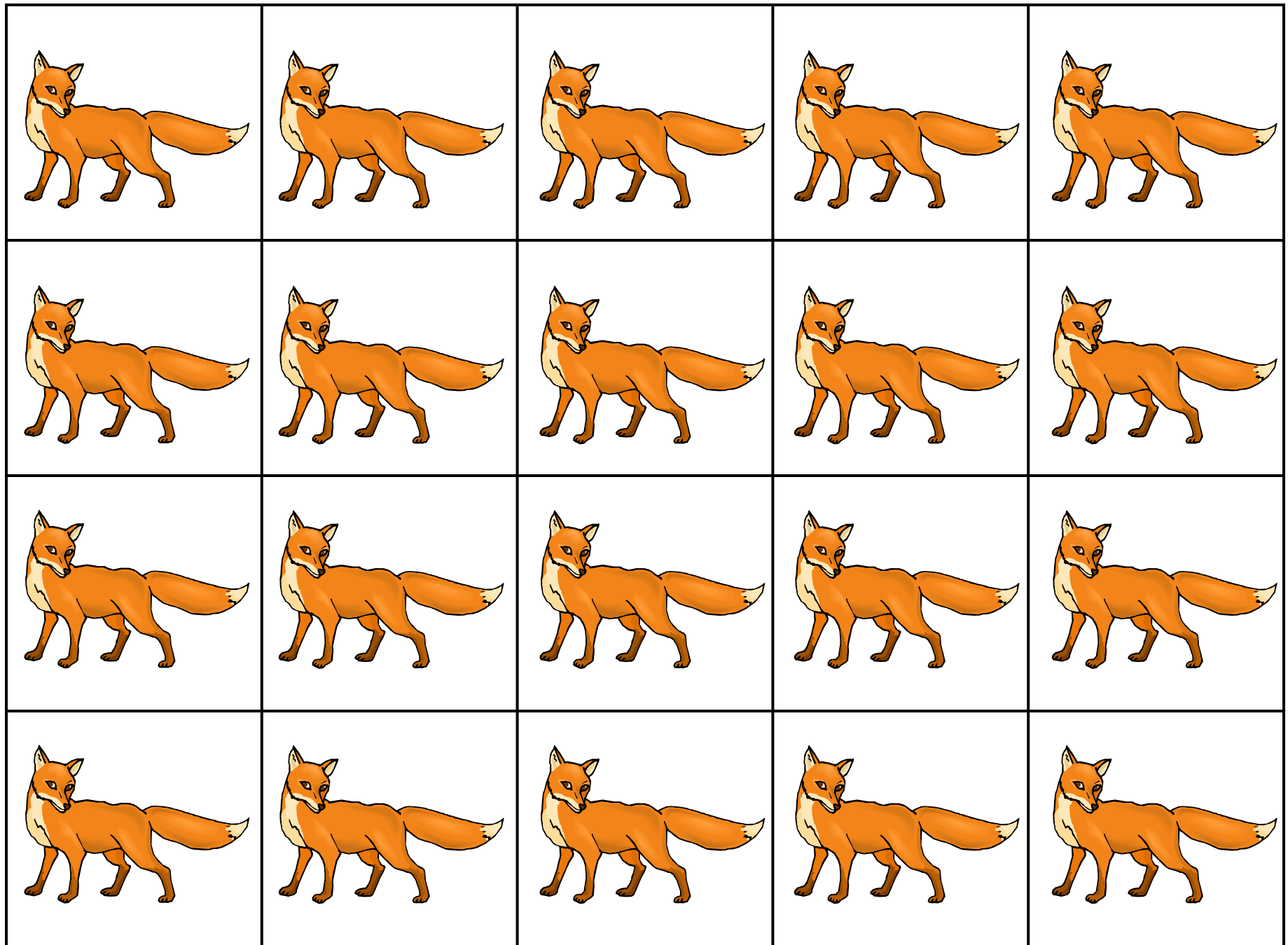
## VERSION 2 (harder)

- \*Place some foxes on the box mat (pg. 2).
- \*Ask your child to count the number of foxes.
- \*Help him locate and trace the correct number (with the number tracer cards, pp. 5-6)

## VERSION 3 (hardest)

- \*Place some foxes on the box mat and then more.
- \*Pose is as a problem to the child such as "3 foxes fell in the box. Then, 4 more fell in! How many foxes are there in the box now?"
- \*The child solves the problem and locates the number (from pg. 4) or locates AND traces the number (with the number tracer cards, pp. 5-6)

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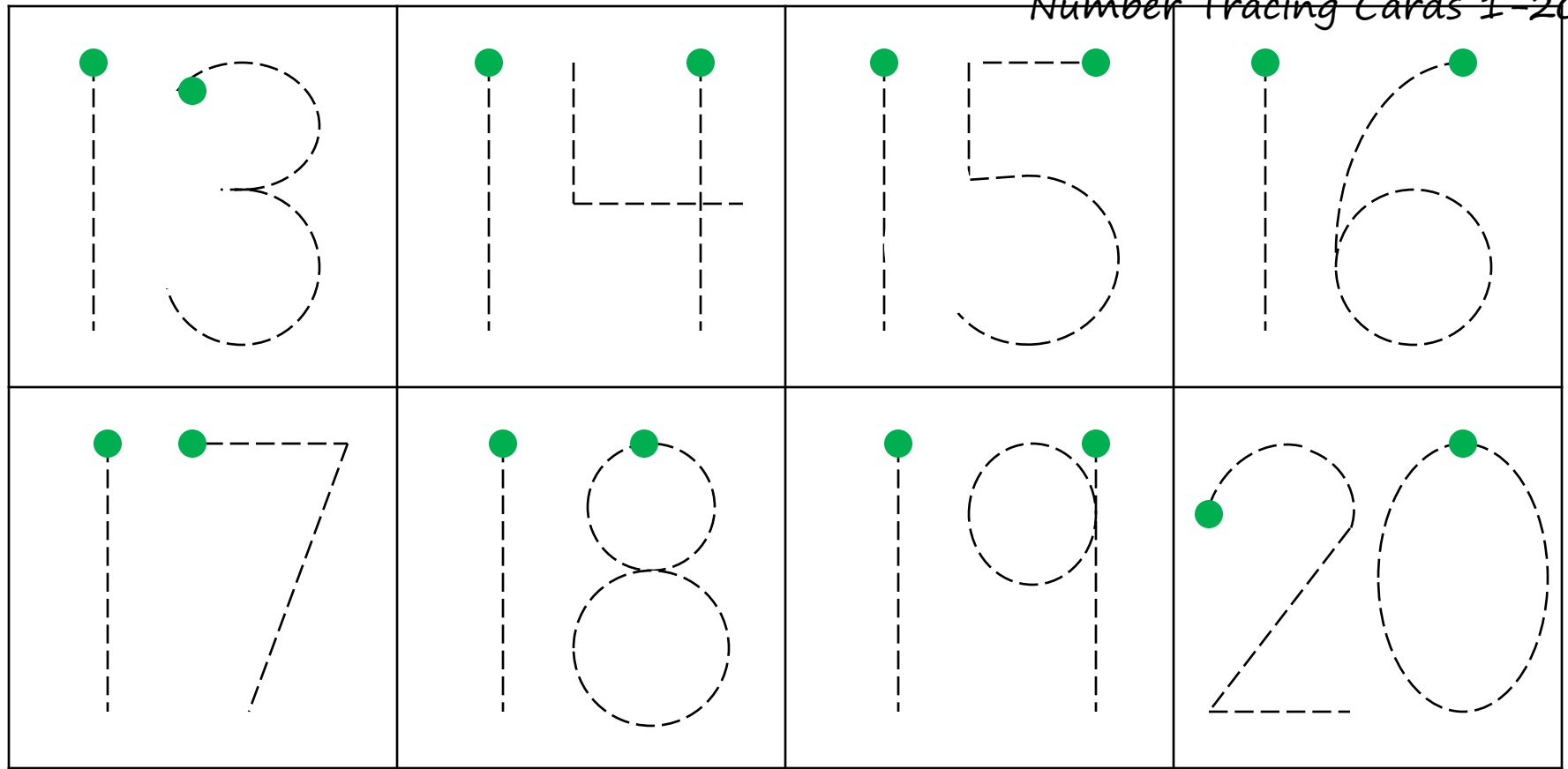
