

Easy Trick for the b/d Reversal

There are many tricks to help with the b/d reversal, but this one is highly effective. I've seen it work firsthand with Kindergartners all the way through 5th graders.

The lowercase *b* fits right inside the uppercase *B*! Why is this trick so effective? Because uppercase letters are more distinguishable. Confusing uppercase *B* and *D* is much less common than confusing lowercase *b* and *d*.

Print these single posters and place them in a prominent place where students can see and use as a reference. Included in this pack are posters without a rhyme and posters with a simple rhyme:

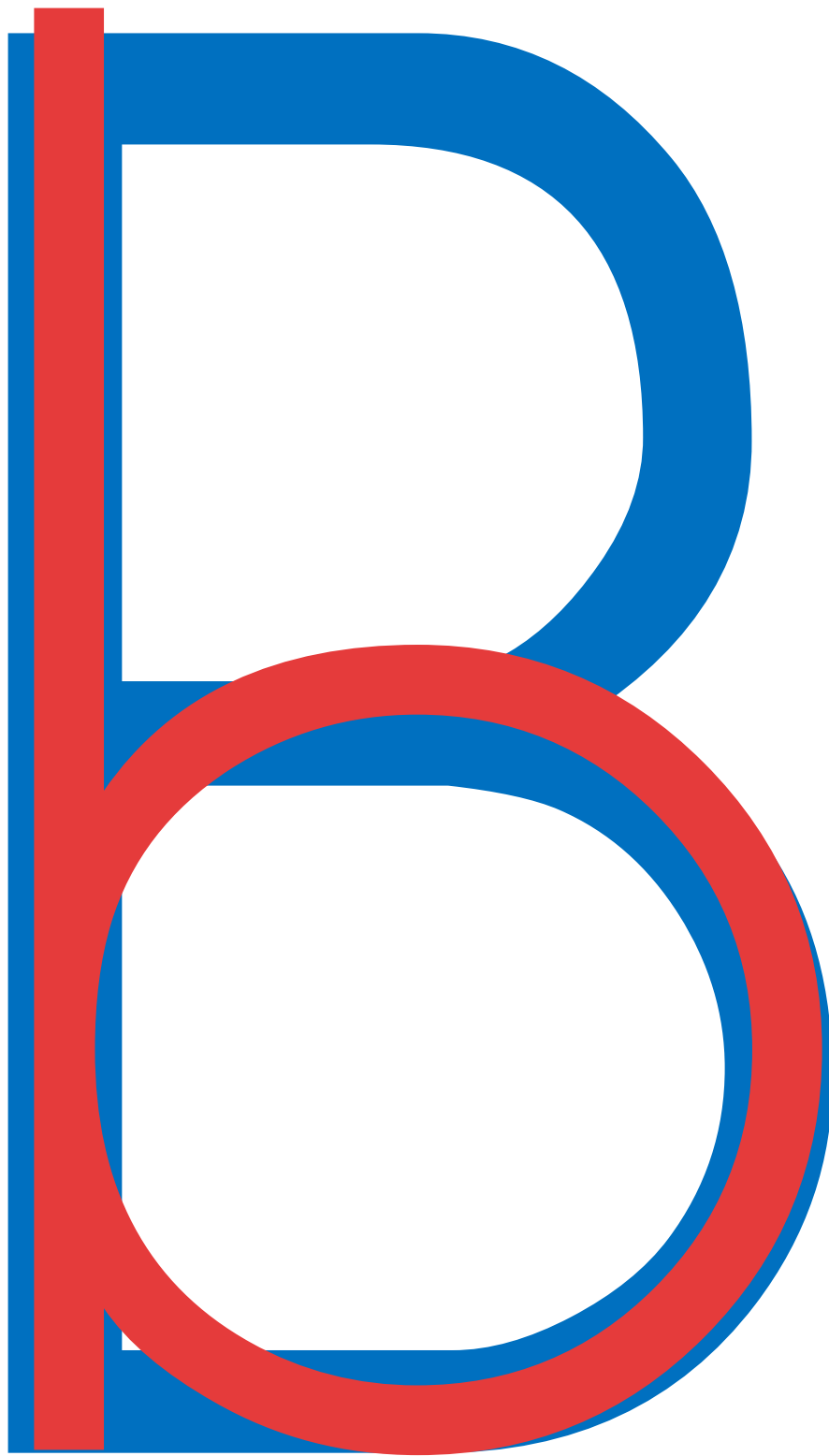


Lowercase **b**, as you can see,
fits so nicely in uppercase **B**.

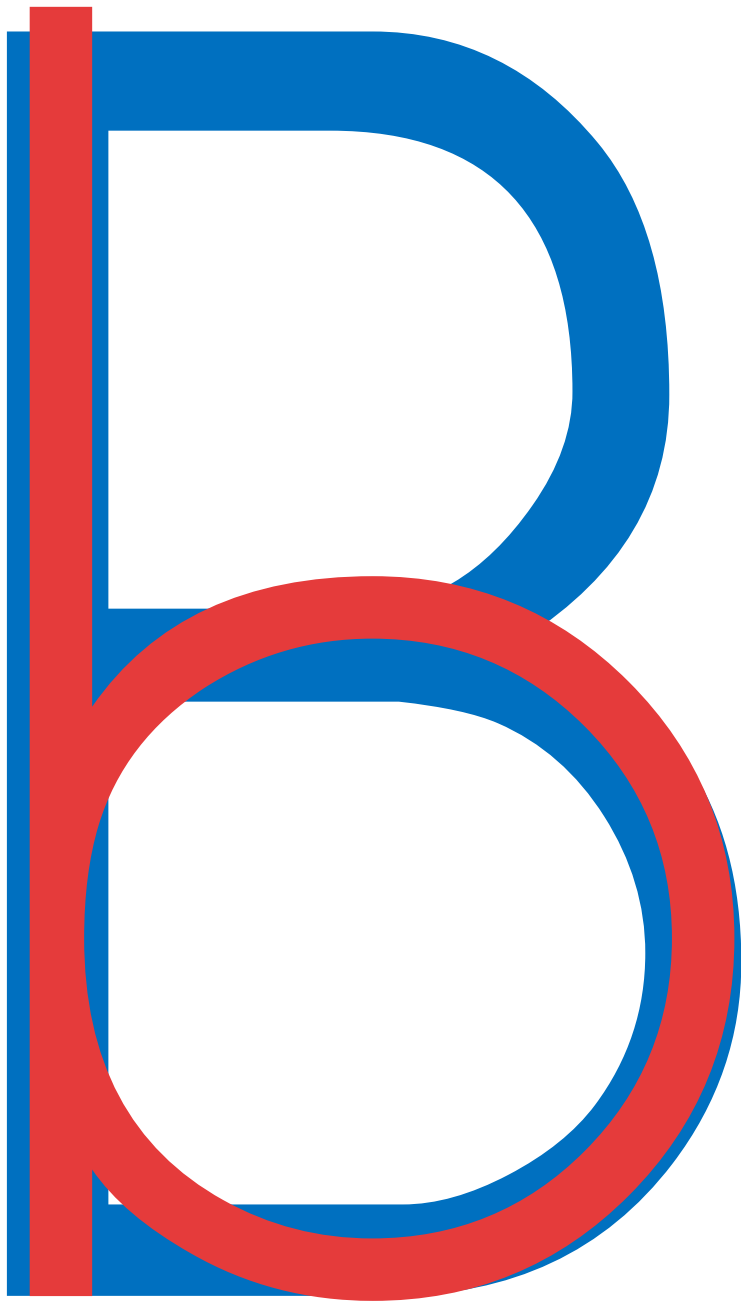
