Reader	<b>A Promise from God</b> Read the text to your child; discuss any vocabulary words, such as <i>command</i> , <i>serpent</i> , <i>quest</i> , <i>tempt</i> , <i>fret</i>	Shared reading of the text; introduce words you think may be tricky; let your child read some of the sentences with you	Release more responsibility to your child to read more of the text herself	Word Hunt through text (see Short o activity)	Child reads text with limited support
Short o	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Introduce <b>Short o Word sort</b></li> <li>•Reshuffle words, let child sort with support</li> </ul>	Re-sort words & color code words by word chunks (-OT, -OCK, & -OP)	<b>Little Words</b> with the word <b>STRONG</b>	Word Hunt: Use head words from the short o word sort and find other words to match the pattern (see post)	Blind sort: Lay out the head words. As you call out words, have your child point to the head word under which each belongs
Sight Words	Intro new words for your child (5 at the most); see <i>A Promise From God</i> Reader & Word-Wac-Woe for sight words	<b>Secret Sentence</b> activity sheet	Spell words with magnetic letters or letter tiles	<b>Roll &amp; Write a Sentence</b>	<b>Word-Wac-Woe</b> (sight word cards for lesson included)
Writing		Prompt: Draw & write how you think Abraham felt when God told him he would have many in his family.	Pick 5 sight words and write sentences with them, relating to the Bible story.	Prompt: Can you think of a promise God give us in His Word? Write about it.	Dictation sentence: <i>God did as He said and made her a mom.</i>
Bible Verse	Read from the Bible: Psalm 145:13, "The Lord is faithful to all His promises."	<b>Cut &amp; Paste Bible Verse:</b> Child cuts words apart and glues them back in order on a piece of paper.	Make up motions to go with your Bible verse. If you know sign language, try that!	Discuss with your child what a promise is and the different promises of God in Scripture. Then, use the prompt from writing.	Can you say the Bible verse without looking?
