

Passports for Traveling the World

How to Make an Apple Pie and See the World by Majorie Priceman

Print page 2 of download (Passport cover) onto cardstock.
Fold in half on vertical line and use as the cover for your book



Print page 3-6 onto regular copy paper and cut on vertical lines. Assemble and staple the passport in this order: Info sheet, Italy, France, Sri Lanka, England, Jamaica, & Vermont. The blank half from pg. 3 could be placed at the end and used for the child to draw a picture of his/her home.

Pg. 3 - Ask students to draw a picture of themselves and fill in the personal info in each blank. If the child does not know the name of her favorite apple, ask her to write the color of her favorite apple.

Pgs. 4-6 Cut out the flags/ingredients (pg. 7 of download) and glue them to the corresponding pages of the passport.

Once the passport is finished, ask the child to retell the story, using the passport as support. You may even want to "stamp" each page as the story is retold with a stamp and ink pad.

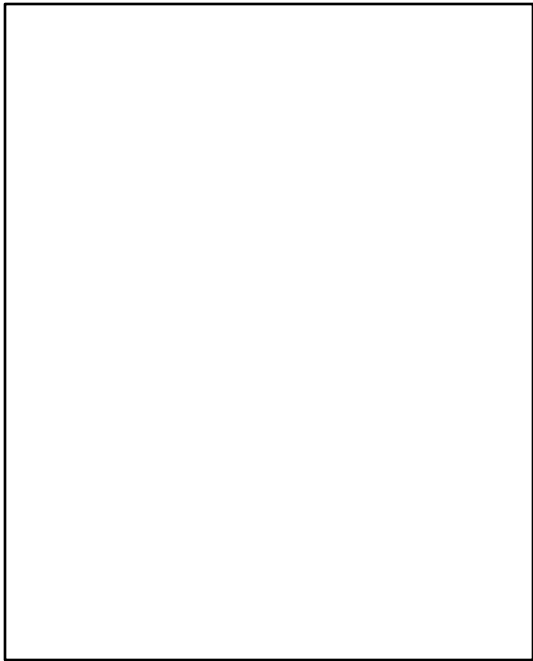
