Day 1

1. Review Previous Letter Books (from Lessons 1-30)

- Let your child choose which books he'd like to re-read with you. Read as many as his attention span can handle.

2. Sight Word Review Search

3. Review Letter Tracing and Past Tracer Pages {from Lessons 1-30}

4. Bottle Cap UG Mats

- directions are on the printable; there are three different ways to do this activity (leveled)

5. Roll a Rhyme

- This is an extra activity that you and your child may enjoy doing together. Further directions are on the download.

Day 2

1. Review Previous Letter Books (from Lessons 1-30)

- Let your child choose which books he'd like to read with you. If you didn't get to any of the books yesterday, try those first.

2. Roll and Stamp (UG Family)

- Place the education inserts into your cubes (if you don't have these, see the printable for further ideas on adapting this)
- Roll and graph the results-further directions are on activity

3. UG Puzzles- further directions are on the activity

4. Rug Numbers 1-10, 10-20, and Rug Sums

- There are three levels on the download and directions are on each activity for how to play.

Day 3

1. Pocket Chart UG Match with Pictures and UG Words

- Directions for this activity are on the printable

2 Bug in the Rug Reader

- Leave the Pocket Chart UG Match cards and pictures visible for extra support
- Locate all the UG words in the text (bug, jug, mug, rug, & tug) and remind the child that he just built the words on the pocket chart
- Read the text together, providing as much support as needed

3. Rug Color by Sight Word

3. BUG Tracer Page

- Use a pencil, marker, or crayon to trace the word BUG and the picture

Day 4

1. Pocket Chart UG, ET, OT, & AT sorting- Pull out the ET {Lesson 26}, OT {Lesson 20} and AT pictures {Lesson 7}. Identify each picture, emphasizing the ET, OT, and AT rimes. Sort each picture. Further directions are on download.

2. Bug in the Rug Reader

- Re-read the text together, providing support when needed

3. Build A Word (Sight Word Review)

Follow directions on printable

4. How Many Bugs on the Rug?

- There are several different levels are included and directions are on the first page for each level. Pick the one that fits the level of your child.

Day 5

1. Bug in the Rug Reader

- Ask child to read independently and celebrate his success together!

2. Bug Print Awareness-directions on printable

3. UG Cutting Practice & Pattern Cards-directions on download

4. Bottle Cap UG, AT, IG, OT, & ET Words- I made an all-in-one printable to save on ink. Further directions are on the printable. If you feel your child is not ready, pull out the separate Bottle Cap Spelling Mats from the previous lessons.
